

Definitions

Native – Plants that occur naturally in their region and habitat, where over the course of time they have adapted to physical conditions and other species of the region.

Drought tolerant - Drought-tolerant landscaping and plants can grow or thrive with minimal water or rainfall, meaning that plants survive on average or less than usual rain in a particular region.

Pollinator Plants - Virtually all of the world's seed plants need to be pollinated, although some plants produce much more pollen than others. Pollination is an essential part of plant reproduction.
